Who Should Attend

Method of Evaluation

Evaluation is achieved by means of continuous assessment by the trainer throughout the day. A short multiple choice exam paper is also completed by the candidates. Successful Learners will receive a QA Level 2 Award in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation and Automated External Defibrillation (QCF) certificate as well as a plastic aide memoir and course reference manual.

An annual re qualification would be required to maintain the skills learnt during this course.
